Code of Conduct

By joining any Double Dot Squash Competition you agree to the Code of Conduct and other relevant policies.

- Follow all competition rules, policies, and guidelines set by Double Dot Squash, the club, Squash Auckland, and Squash New Zealand.
- Display good sportsmanship at all times to others.
- Behave appropriately at all times and never in a way which may endanger or risk the safety of yourself or others.
- Do not use inappropriate language or actions at any time.
- Show respect to all players, spectators, coaches, referees, tournament managers, and others.
- Respect all referee and tournament management decisions.

Failure to adhere to the Code of Conduct will result in various actions depending on the severity of the breach.
